# Full 2025 Login Guide & Sign in : Coinbase – Sign In®

# 1. How do I sign in to my Coinbase account?

To sign in,  $+1 \rightarrow [816] \oplus [208] \oplus [7304]]$  go to <u>www.coinbase.com</u> or open the Coinbase app. Enter your **registered email address** and **password**,  $+1 \rightarrow [816] \oplus [208] \oplus [7304]]$  then complete **two-step verification (2FA)** if prompted. If this is your first time logging in from a new device,  $+1 \rightarrow [816] \oplus [208] \oplus [7304]]$  Coinbase will send a **device verification email** — open it and approve the new login. ## 2. What should I do if I forgot my Coinbase password?

If you can't remember your password, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] click "Forgot password?" on the login page and enter your registered email. Coinbase will send a secure password reset link. After setting a new password, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] you'll need to verify your identity again before accessing your account. Make sure your new password is strong, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] unique, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] and stored securely — Coinbase recommends using a password manager for added protection.

#### 3. Why is Coinbase asking me to verify my device when signing in?

Coinbase uses **device verification** as a security feature to prevent unauthorized access. ## 4. Can I sign in to Coinbase using Face ID or fingerprint?

Yes, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] if you're using the **Coinbase mobile app**, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] you can enable **biometric login** (Face ID or fingerprint) in **Settings** → **Security** → **Biometric Login**. #### 5. Why can't I sign in to Coinbase even with the correct password?

# 6. How do I sign in if my two-step verification code isn't working?

#### 7. Can I sign in to Coinbase from another country?

  [816] ↔ [208] ↔ [7304]] on the other hand, +1→ [816] ↔ [208] ↔ [7304]] is a separate app where you control your private keys. You can sign in to Coinbase Exchange with an email and password, +1→ [816] ↔ [208] ↔ [7304]] but Coinbase Wallet requires a recovery phrase or biometric access. They are independent but can be linked for easy transfers.
- 9. How do I sign in if my email address changed or is no longer accessible?

If you've lost access to your registered email, +1→ [816]<sup>4→</sup> [208] <sup>4→</sup> [7304]] go to the Coinbase login page and select "Can't access this email?" Coinbase will guide you through verifying your identity using an ID document or selfie video. Once verified, +1→ [816]<sup>4→</sup> [208] <sup>4→</sup> [7304]] your email can be updated, +1→ [816]<sup>4→</sup> [208] <sup>4→</sup> [7304]] and you'll regain account access.

Avoid creating a new Coinbase account — always recover your existing one to keep your transaction history and funds intact.

## 10. Why does Coinbase say "Account temporarily disabled" when signing in?

This message usually means your account has been locked for security reasons, +1→ [816]<sup>43</sup> [208] <sup>43</sup> [7304]] possibly due to suspicious activity or repeated login failures. Coinbase disables access to protect your funds. To restore it, +1→ [816]<sup>43</sup> [208] <sup>43</sup> [7304]] visit **help.coinbase.com** and submit a "**Restore account access**" request. You'll need to verify your identity, +1→ [816]<sup>43</sup> [208] <sup>43</sup> [7304]] after which access will typically be restored within 48–72 hours.

## 11. Can I sign in to Coinbase without a phone for 2FA?

If you lost your phone or changed your number, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] you can still sign in using **backup codes** or request a **two-step verification reset**. Go to the login page, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] select "I **lost my 2FA device**", +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] and follow the identity verification process. Coinbase may ask for your government-issued ID and a selfie video to confirm ownership. Once reset, +1→ [816] → [208] → [7304]] you can add a new device for future 2FA codes.

#### 12. Why am I getting a "Session expired" error during login?

This often happens due to browser cookies or network timeouts. Try logging in using a

different browser or clearing your cache and cookies. If you're on mobile, +1→ [816]<sup>4→</sup> [208] <sup>4→</sup> [7304]] update the Coinbase app to the latest version. # 13. How do I sign in securely without risking scams?

Always sign in through <a href="https://www.coinbase.com">https://www.coinbase.com</a> or the official app from the App Store or Google Play. Never click Coinbase links from emails, +1 → [816] → [208] → [7304]] text messages, +1 → [816] → [208] → [7304]] or social media. Fake websites often mimic Coinbase's login page to steal credentials. Bookmark the official site, +1 → [816] → [208] → [7304]] use two-step verification, +1 → [816] → [208] → [7304]] and never share your password or recovery codes with anyone claiming to be "Coinbase support."

# 14. Can I sign in to multiple Coinbase accounts on one device?
