## 1. How do I sign in to my Coinbase account?

## 3. Why is Coinbase asking me to verify my device when signing in?

will be denied. Always check that the email is from **no-reply@coinbase.com** and avoid clicking any suspicious links from unofficial sources.

#### 4. Can I sign in to Coinbase using Face ID or fingerprint?
